

## Dissimilar Analogies

Dissimilar means “not alike.”

An analogy means to compare two things.

Therefore, dissimilar analogies are when you compare two things that do not seem to be alike.



### EXAMPLE:

What do a **BOOK** and an **APPLE** have in common?

You might be thinking **NOTHING!**

## NOT VERY CREATIVE ANSWERS

- ▶ You can buy them both at a store.
- ▶ You can read one and eat one.
- ▶ They can both be hard (this one is a little bit creative).



*\*IDEA\**

This is a fun activity to do at dinner with your family!

## CREATIVE ANSWERS!

- ▶ They can both be “red/read”.  
(An apple can be RED and a book can be READ)
- ▶ They both feed you.  
(An apple is food for your body and a book is food for your brain!)
